LEBALA CAMP

SANDBIBE CAMP

OKAVANGO DELTA, BOTSWANA

Papyrus-lined channels and lush lagoons offer an ideal setting for leisurely meanderings by traditional "mekoro" dug-out canoes. SELINDA CAMP

SELINDA RESERVE, BOTSWANA

In addition to exploring vast grasslands and mopane forests, there is excellent fishing at nearby Zibadianja Lagoon. Savor fine vintages from the wine cellar, and sip tea with a view of the floodplain. The Meru tents—set on the Selinda Spillway—offer en suite bathrooms, exquisite decor, and private verandas. Selinda infuses modern comforts with an old-world safari feel.



JACK'S CAMP

KALAHARI DESERT, BOTSWANA

Years ago, a certain spot so entranced Jack Bousfield that he set up camp there. Today, that place along the otherworldly Makgadikgadi Salt Pans, is Jack's Camp, a remote oasis in a rugged crossroads of wildlife. This lavish camp introduces guests to the desert's denizens, including prolific wildlife and the rapidly vanishing Bushmen of the Kalahari. TONGABEZI
